

LIST OF EXHIBITS FOR TAA PETITION

1. United States Patent and Trademark Office. Trademark Electronic Search System (TESS) document display. (1 page)

That the Computer Sciences Corporation's (CSC) computer software known as "VANTAGE-ONE" is a LIVE Trademark, registered April 1, 2003. Registration number 2702097.

Trademarks are created and preserved to uniquely identify a brand or product. VANTAGE-ONE is a product as summarily described in the 'Goods and Services' area of the patent as:

"Computer programs and program manuals all sold as a unit for use in insurance and insurance-related financial applications."

This Trademark patent affirms that CSC's VANTAGE-ONE computer software is a unique product and is therefore an 'article' as required by this TAA petition.

2. The 'Confidentiality Statement/Agreement Not to Compete' contract signed by Mark Bain August 31, 1992. (3 pages)

Page 2. The contract states, in part,

"I also agree that for a period of one year following my employment by Vantage Computer System, Inc., I will not (except as a full-time employee of a Vantage Computer System, Inc. software licensee) provide maintenance, modifications or consulting services with respect to any Vantage Computer System, Inc. **software or product.**"

This contract stipulates that the VANTAGE-ONE software is a "product", therefore it is an 'article' as required by this TAA petition.

For the sum of \$10.00 the signer contractually agreed to content of this contract.

The co-signers of this petition can (if requested) produce similar signed and dated 'Confidentiality Statement/Agreement Not to Compete' contracts which state that VANTAGE-ONE is a 'product'.

3. Job dismissal letter addressed to Mark Bain dated May 30, 2003, signed by Patricia J. Folger, Sr. Manager Human Resources, FSG, CSC. (2 pages)

Item 9. "Non-Competition/Non-Disclosure Agreement"

This item states "that any Non-Competition/Non-Disclosure Agreement you signed with CSC remains in place." This means that the 'Confidentiality Statement/Agreement Not to Compete' contract signed by Mark Bain on August 31, 1992 is still a viable contract and enforceable. See item 2 above.

As of May 30, 2003, CSC currently agrees that the VANTAGE-ONE software is a "product", therefore it is an 'article' as required by this TAA petition.

The co-signers of this petition can (if requested) produce identical job dismissal letters which have the same item number nine "Non-Competition/Non-Disclosure Agreement".

4. VANTAGE-ONE Users' Conference Announcement (1 page)

The CSC advertisement for the VANTAGE-ONE Users' Conference, October 26-29, 2003 to be held in Nashville TN. CSC sponsored Users' Conferences are a professional forum whereby owners or licensees of the Trademarked product known as VANTAGE-ONE, collaborate to identify their future business needs and how those business needs will be manufactured (DESIGNED, CODED, TESTED, DELIVERED) into the future versions of the VANTAGE-ONE software.

This future-dated conference thereby affirms that the VANTAGE-ONE product continues to be manufactured after May 30, 2003.

5. October 21, 2002 newspaper article by the Austin TX American-Statesman. (3 pages)

Page 3. A quote by Jim Cook, President of Computer Sciences Corp., Financial Services Group (FSG) division. The FSG division manufactures the Trademarked product known as VANTAGE-ONE. The quote by Mr. Cook affirms that 'offshore resources' are being used by the division.

"Many of you may ask if your job is being replaced by the use of offshore resources," wrote division President Jim Cook. "We have added offshore resources in order to win business that requires this element in our solution, business we could not have won otherwise."

6. 'Mark Bain, KRA's, April 2003 – March 2004'. (2 pages)

(KRA = Key Requirement Areas)

KRA's are CSC terminology for short descriptions of the elements that define an employee's responsibilities. ie. a job task description.

Item 3. Offshore Component.

One of Mark Bain's job task descriptions is to "integrate offshore component into E&S". "E&S" is the Enhancements and Services division of the Financial Services Group of CSC. The E&S department manufactures the Trademarked product VANTAGE-ONE. The knowledge and skills associated with the manufacture of the Trademarked product VANTAGE-ONE is to be taught to the 'offshore component'.

Item 6. Leadership Skills & abilities

"Provide team members with clear, concise and consistent leadership and direction".

TAA co-signers Monali Patel and Deborah Corkindale were "team members" which Mark Bain provided leadership to. The "direction" was to execute Item 3 above, "integrate offshore component into E&S".

7. "2003 Annual Appraisal for MARK I BAIN" (12 pages)

Measures employee job performance for the period of April 1, 2002 to March 31, 2003.

Page 6. KRA EVALUATION.

KRA : **"Implement offshore component"**

Rating : "Surpassed"

Comments : "Mark was extremely successful at coordinating and communicating with the offshore component. He initiated & implemented process and procedures to ensure clear direction and expectations".

As a team lead in the E&S department of the FSG division of CSC, Mark Bain had "surpassed" in his directions to TAA co-signers Monali Patel and Deborah Corkindale to "implement offshore component" in the manufacture of the Trademarked product VANTAGE-ONE.

8. Memo from Mark Bain to persons in Noida, India, dated 4/16/2003. (6 pages)

Page 1.

This is one example of a daily memo to persons in Noida, India, directing those persons in the manufacture of the CSC Trademarked product known as VANTAGE-ONE. It is not obvious that the

persons listed in the “To:” area of the memo are located in India. These are their ‘CSC short email names’ as listed on the CSC LOTUS NOTES email computer server and can be verified as such. CSC can provide the geographical location of all the persons listed on this memo whose surnames are :

The above thirteen (13) persons listed on this memo were located in the CSC operated facility in Noida, India when it was written on April 16, 2003.

Page 6.

The respondent to the memo, surname Chawla, indicates that the respondent’s address is :
“CSC India Pvt Ltd, C-25 Sector 58 , **Noida**, UP – 201301.

Supplemental Information :

Up until 2/28/2003, Mark Bain was directing TAA co-signer Monali Patel on how to train the ‘offshore component’ in her task specific knowledge. Images of these memos will exist on computer backup tapes in the CSC East Hartford, CT facility.

Up until 5/30/2003, Mark Bain was directing TAA co-signer Deborah Corkindale on how to train the ‘offshore component’ in her task specific knowledge. Images of these memos will exist on computer backup tapes in the CSC East Hartford, CT facility.

9. News article by RDSL dated June 23 2003 (1 page)

Responsive Database Services Limited (RDSL) is an IT news organization located in the United Kingdom.

June 23, 2003 announcement by CSC that the CSC “IT services Group aims to double it’s workforce in India to 1600 employees by April 2004”. (“IT” is an acronym for Information Technology).

Information Technology is one of CSC’s ‘horizontal rings’ which supports every product division in CSC. The CSC Financial Services Group is a product division which uses Information Technology.

The E&S department of the FSG division relies heavily on Information Technology in the manufacture of the Trademarked product VANTAGE-ONE.

10. From the CSC WEB site, www.csc.com, July 14, 2003. (1 page)

An announcement that the CSC India facilities are now staffed with 1000 employees and that it will grow by 60% within the ‘end of the current financial year’. The end of the CSC fiscal year for 2003 will be March 30, 2004.

The Trademarked VANTAGE-ONE product is now manufactured at the CSC facility in Noida, India.
